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Pupils should wear sensible clothing, which is suitable for school. Uniform is available to purchase from the office.

Please send in sufficient spare clothing if your child needs changing or if you wish him/her to wear outdoor clothing at playtime.

Clothing should respect the child's dignity and vulnerability. Please ensure that low cut or revealing tops are not worn in school and that trousers pull up to the waist.

Please label all items of school uniform, PE and swimming kit including towels.

Pupils should wear appropriate school footwear that ensures their safety and is suitable for the activities. Supportive, comfortable full shoe should be worn in class – no open toe sandals or heels.

**IT IS COMPULSORY THAT ALL PUPILS SHOULD BE PROVIDED WITH THE FOLLOWING:**

- Swimming costume/trunks and towel
- Swimming pads as appropriate.
- PE shorts and T-shirt
- Tracksuit for winter months.
- Training shoes/ plimsolls.
- Waterproof trouser and jacket to leave in school for outdoor learning activities.
- Wellington boots.
- In summer sun hat and sun cream.
- In colder weather a warm waterproof coat, hat and gloves.
- If your child uses incontinence products or sanitary pads these must be provided as required and baby wipes as appropriate.

ALL ITEMS MUST BE LABELLED WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME.

Please let staff know if you want PE kits left in school and just sent home at half term or if you want to send them in daily.

We appreciate your support in providing these so that we can provide an exciting range of activities to the pupils.

**If your child does not have the appropriate clothing for activities, they will not be able to access the curriculum fully.**
