The MOVE program at Enham trust is a UK based charity expanding the use of the MOVE throughout Europe, bringing opportunities for mobility and independence to those with severe physical disabilities and/or complex needs.

The MOVE program works with Local Authorities, schools and organisations to enable pupils with physical disabilities to reach their full potential.

MOVE is a process which is broken down into several categories such as sitting, sitting to move, standing, walking and many more.

We also look at what the pupil can do and NOT what they can't do!

We involve pupils whenever we can in goal setting, as we want pupils to look towards their own future and personal learning.

The main priority for MOVE is to provide opportunities for pupils to develop functional life skills which will lead to greater independence.



MOVE at Alfreton Park

At Alfreton Park we have been delivering the MOVE program for several years. We have a wide range of staff trained as MOVE practitioners, and four staff members are MOVE trainers.

We select pupils for the MOVE program who have complex physical needs of various ages and cognitive capabilities.

Alfreton Park strongly believe that all pupils have the ability to achieve their full potential.

In order for MOVE to take place successfully a whole team approach is needed.

Members of the team consist of the pupil, family, school, physiotherapists, occupational therapists and respite care.
