Cherry

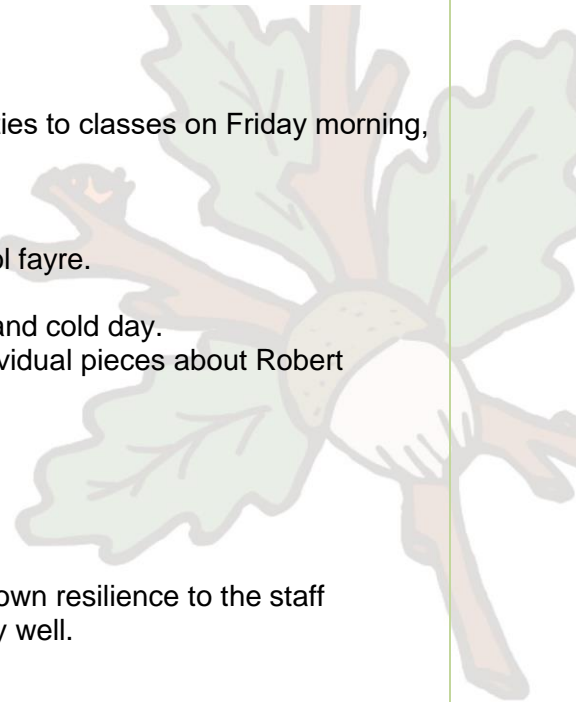
- Jessie** for artistic flair and musical talent.
