Henri for excellent signing during an interaction with an adult; asking for "more" and "help" when he needed it.

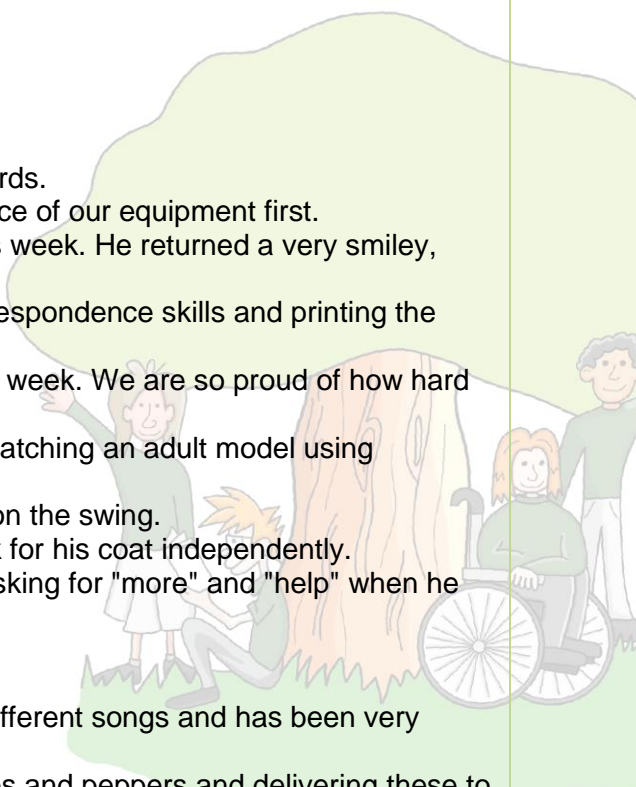
**Beech**

### Juniper

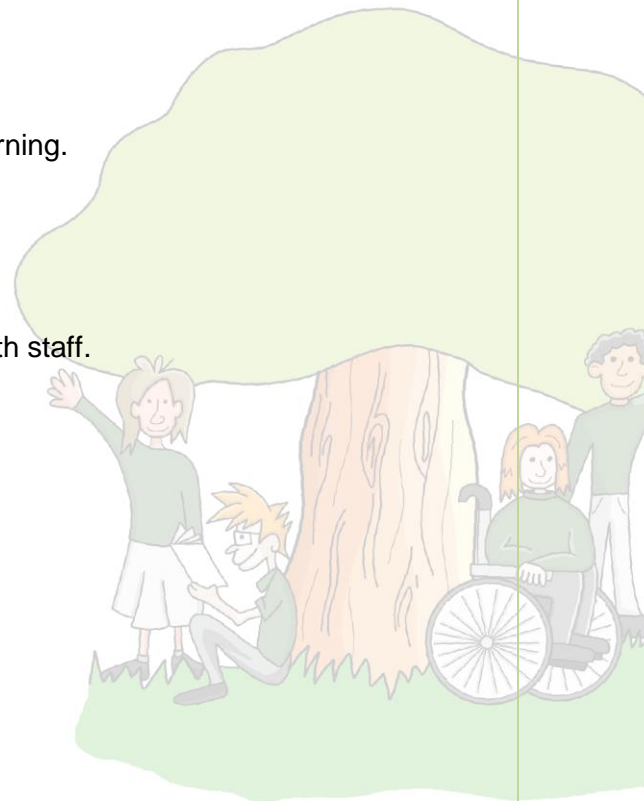
SJ - Communication has been brilliant and worked really hard in equipment.

### **Cherry**

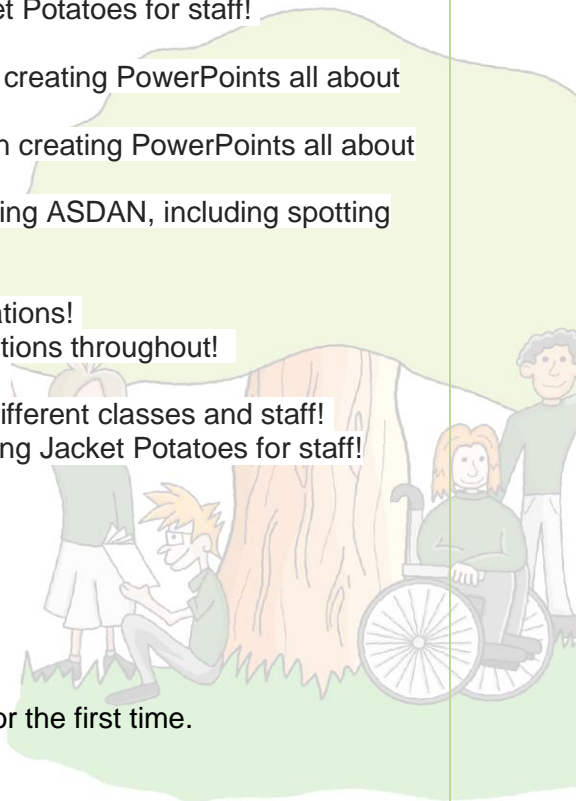
NM - waited beautifully behind pupils when walking to the hall.
