How can you help?

Earlier this year we shared a post on Dojo kindly asking that parents do not send nut products in packed lunches. This includes nut bars, nut based dairy alternatives, Nutella spread, peanut butter etc.

This is because we have pupils with known nut allergy and a member of staff with a known nut allergy in school every day.

Whilst we acknowledge we cannot 'officially' declare ourselves a completely nut free zone as this would not be something we could 100% guarantee, we do have strategies in place to minimise the risk of cross contamination and accidental access to nuts as much as possible.

We ask the same of staff as we do our families and truly thank you for your support and cooperation in keeping all members of our school community as safe as possible.
