Frankie for learning a range of signs during singing hands.

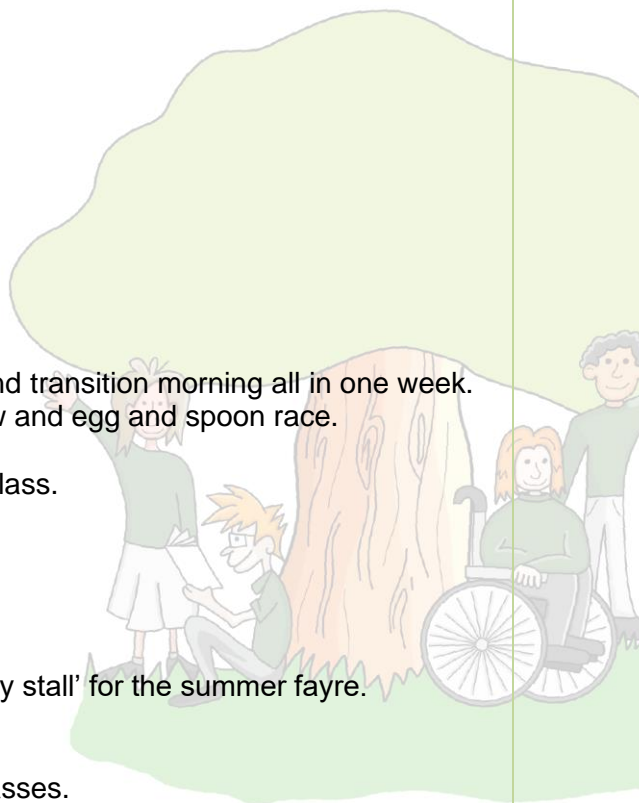
Jake for helping with the laminating jobs in class.

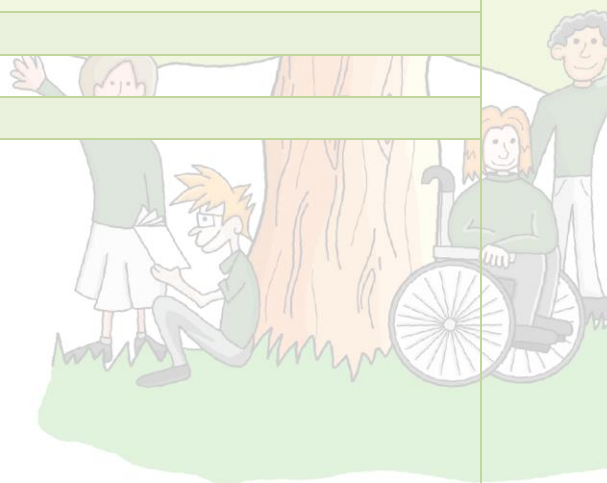
