Killian for engagement with attention autism and friends.

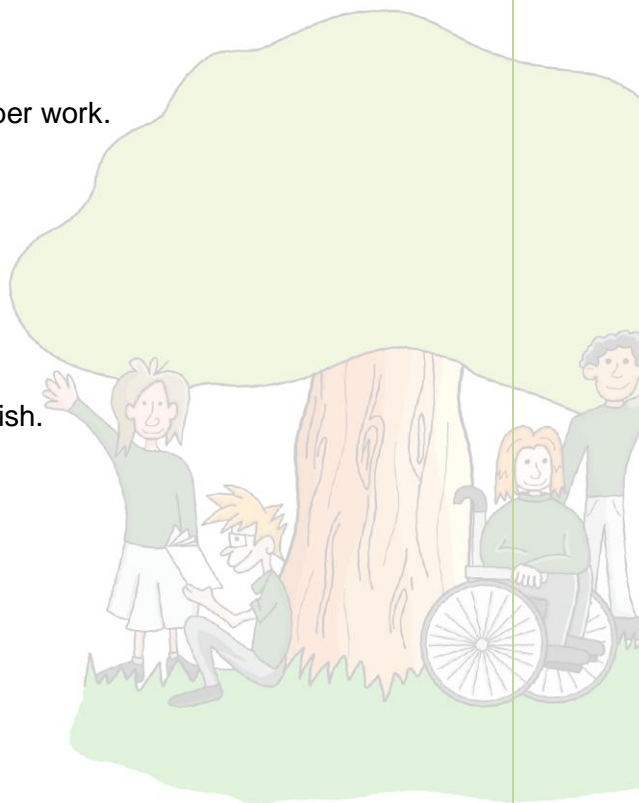
J for good exploring the phonics tray.

Sharissa-Doing fantastic walking in her new walker.

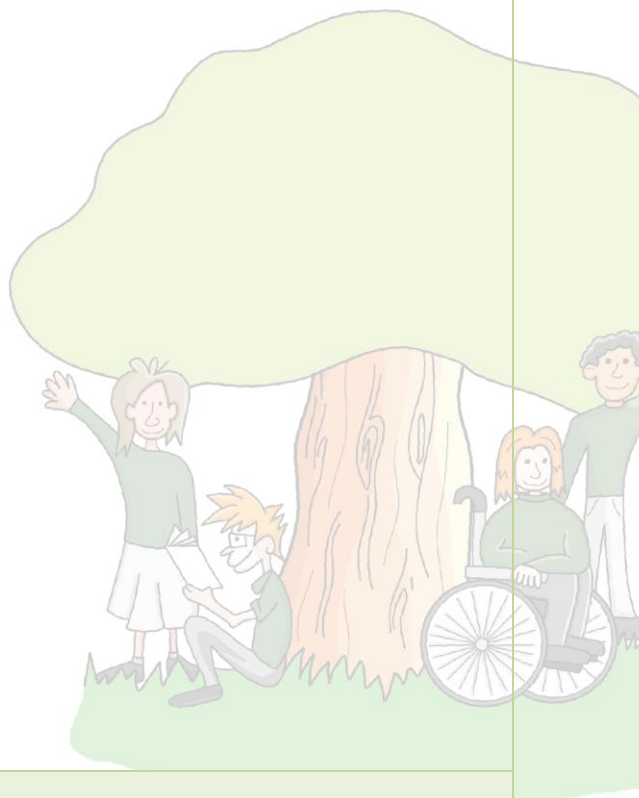
