If you're aged 18 to 24 and have an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP), come along to any to any of our open days to explore the internships on offer to discover if they're right for you.

On the day, you will find out about the support available and learn about what a typical day as an intern is like.

What is Project SEARCH?

Project SEARCH is a one-year supported internship programme for young people with special educational needs.

Interns complete their internship in a real workplace with the support of a job coach, tutor and department mentor.

The programme helps young people to successfully transition into adult life and work towards full-time, paid employment.

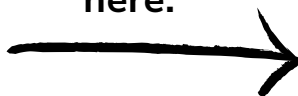
What do I get out of programme?
