Willow

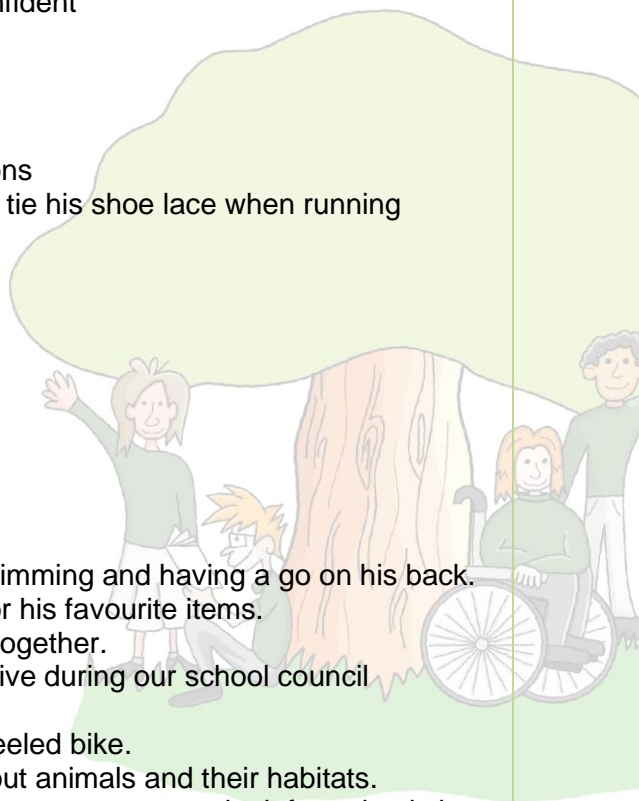
Jared - Amazing self-regulation when he wasn't feeling his best
