Haydn for some super jumping during our warm up in PE.

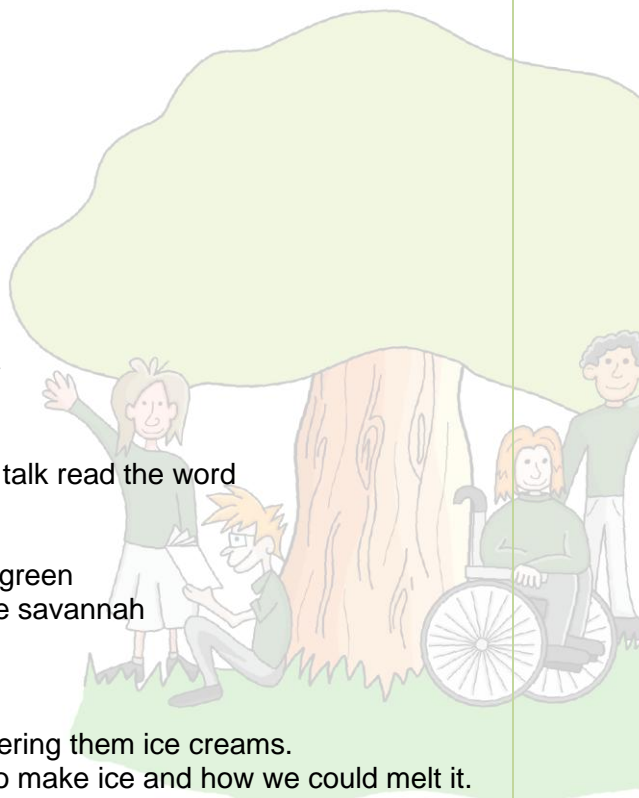
Reggie for interacting so wonderfully with a peer during play offering them ice creams.

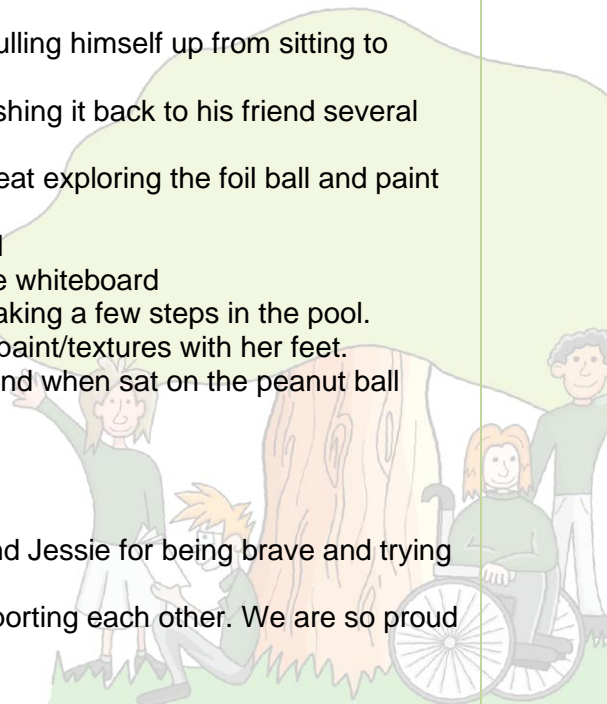
Everyone for a lovely trip to Lea Green, being brilliant friends supporting each other. We are so proud of you.
