Willow

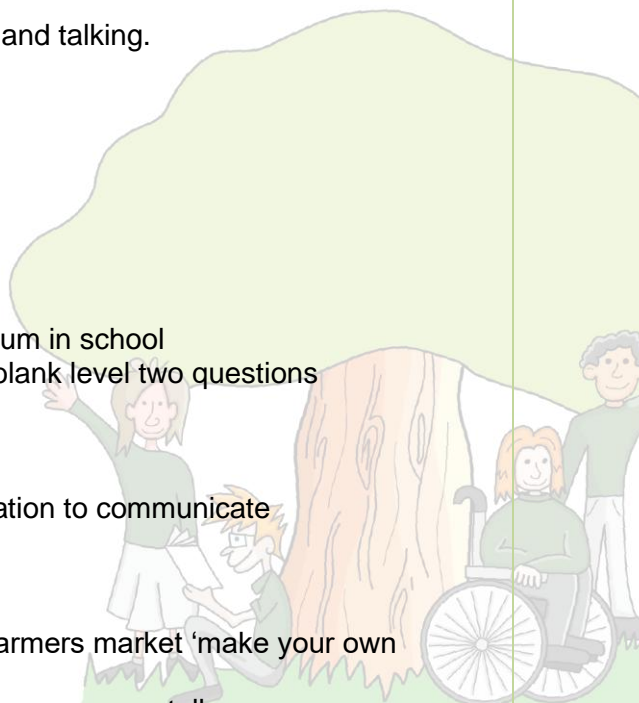
Eli - Took an adult to his backpack and ear defenders when he needed them.

Sarah engaged well with peers and listened really well in PE.

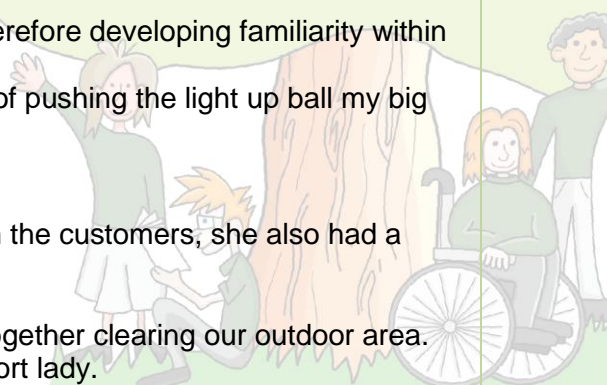
Leo, Max, Billy, Sarah, Rosie, Lara and Kian worked really hard together clearing our outdoor area.
