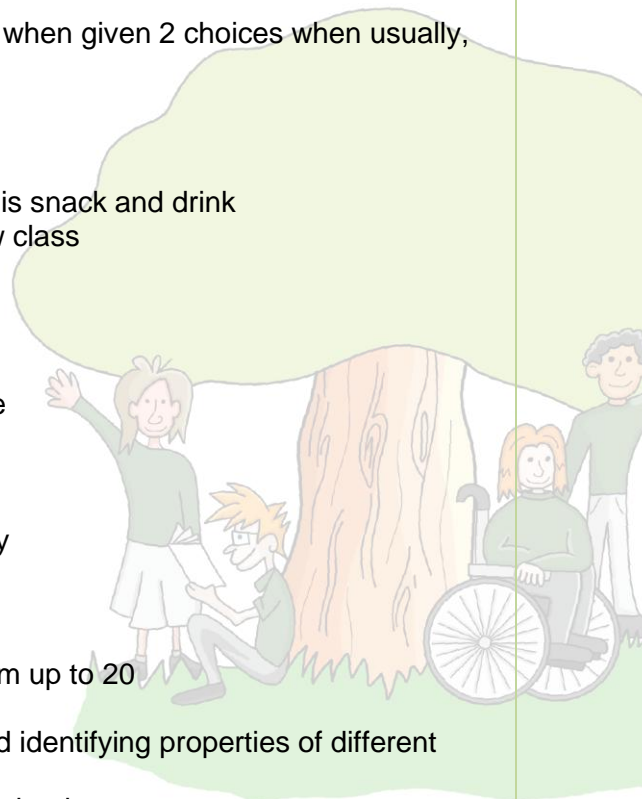
L - had a lovely transition morning in his new class.

Killian for exploring in art, moving the rolling pin and bubble wrap backwards and forwards into paint to make marks

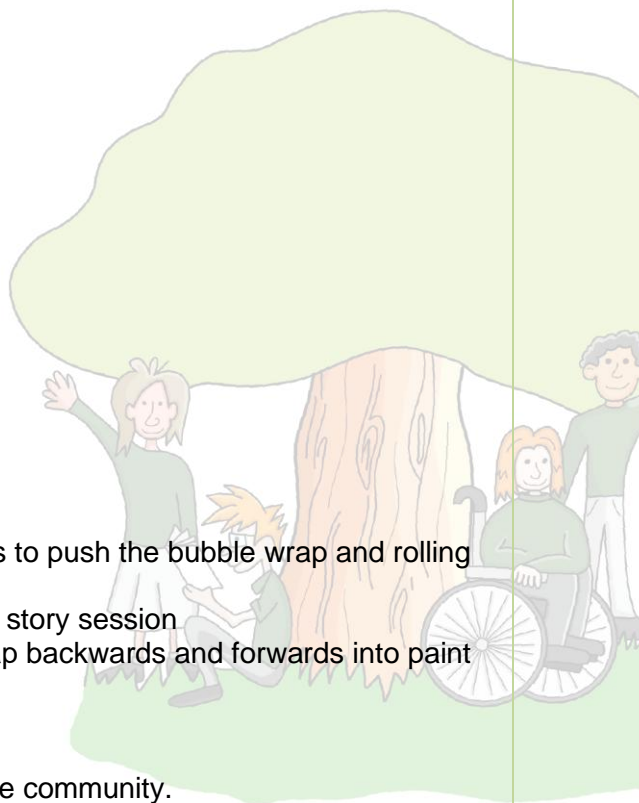
Holly

Lewis - for great listening and following instructions at the cinema

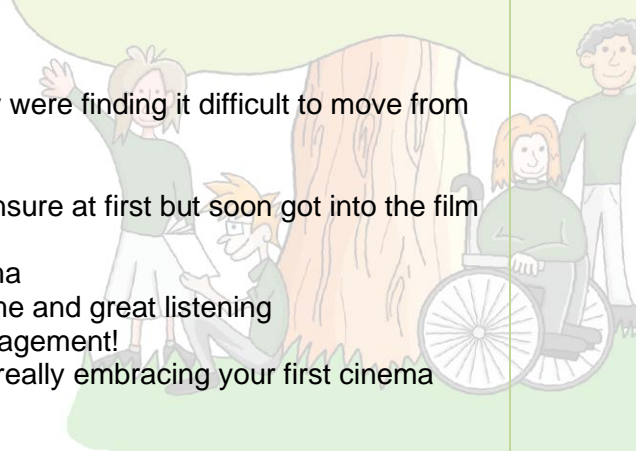
Logan - for some wonderful interaction with staff during story time and great listening
