Bertie for his beautiful reading during a 1:1 session and his enthusiasm during phonics.

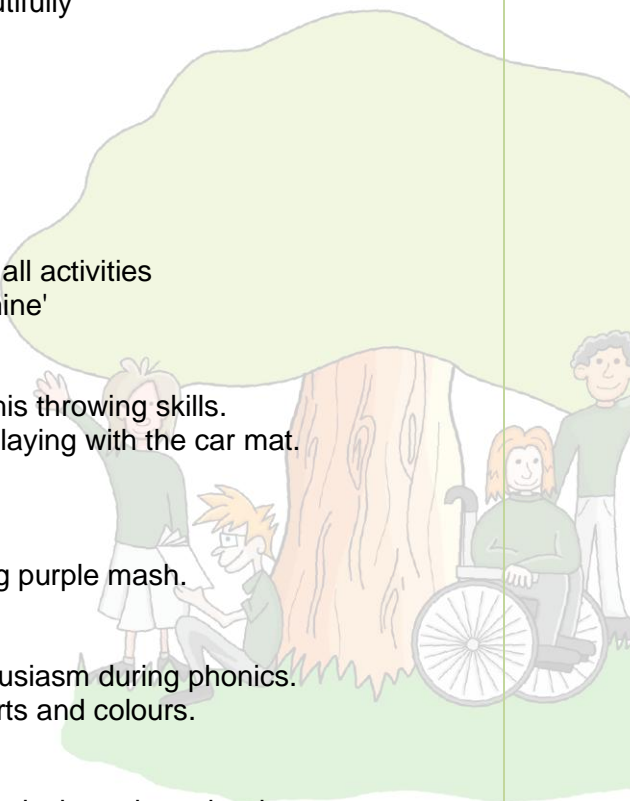
Reece for his great work whilst on purple mash naming body parts and colours.
