J - amazing times tables work

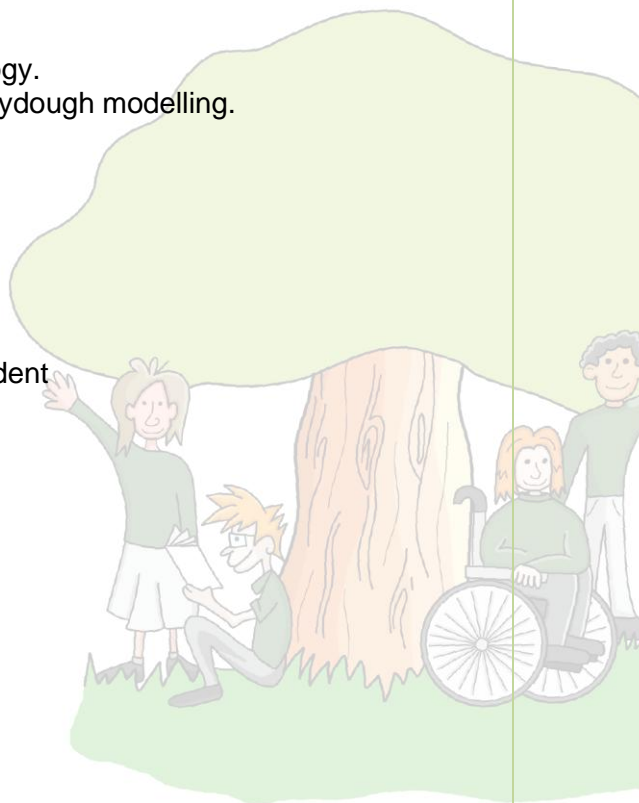

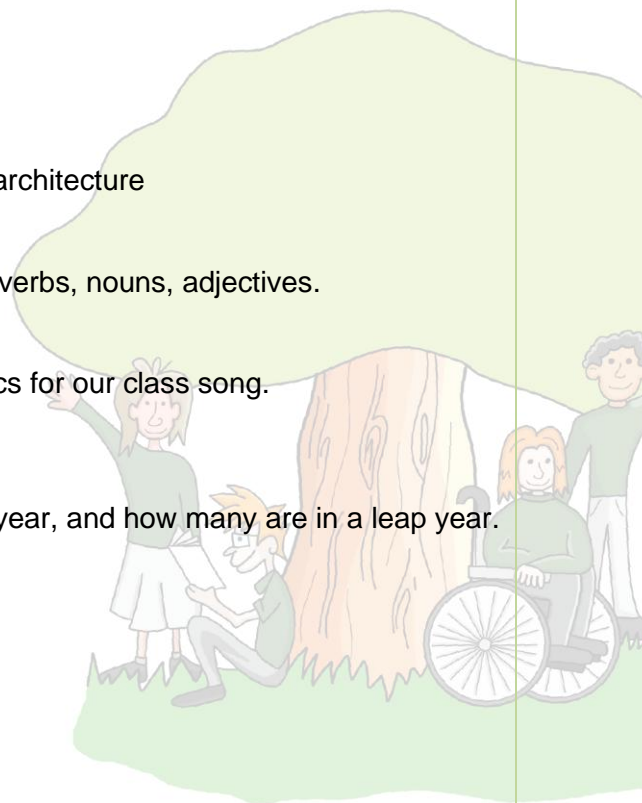
Riley - for saying 'I want more', and for trying loads of new food from Iraq.
