Bradley for participating really well in a STEAM activity, mixing colours and predicting what colour they would turn.

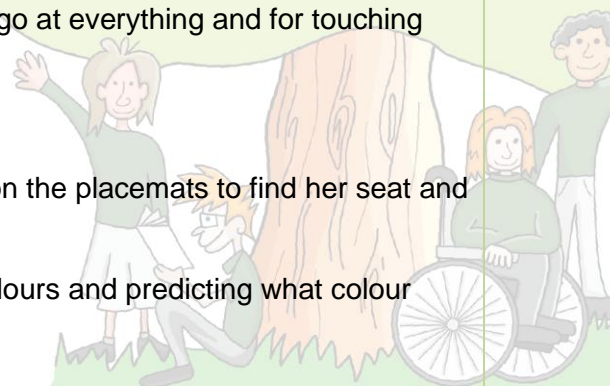
Mason for being kind and sharing toys with a peer.

Shey - for wearing a helmet on the scooter this week and not taking it off! Well done!

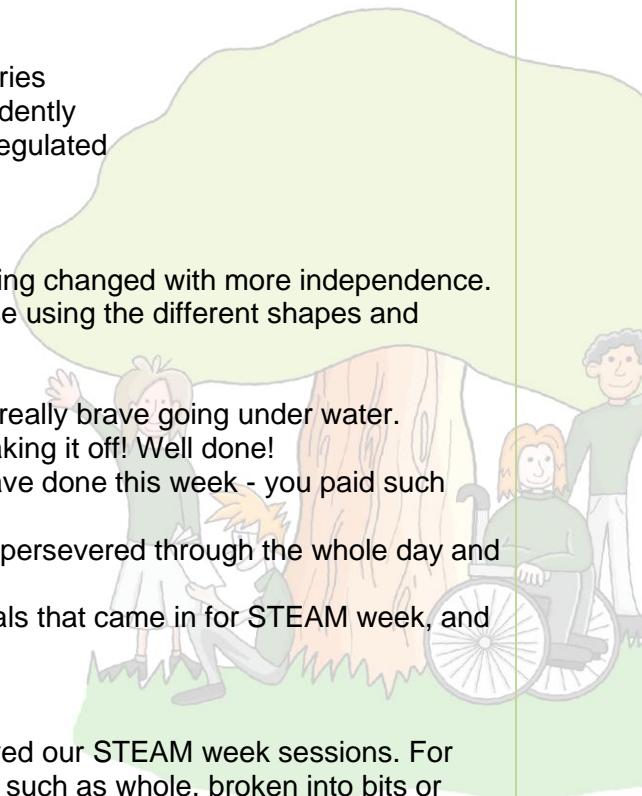
Maggie - for joining in with all of the science experiments we have done this week - you paid such close attention and followed the instructions.

### Sycamore

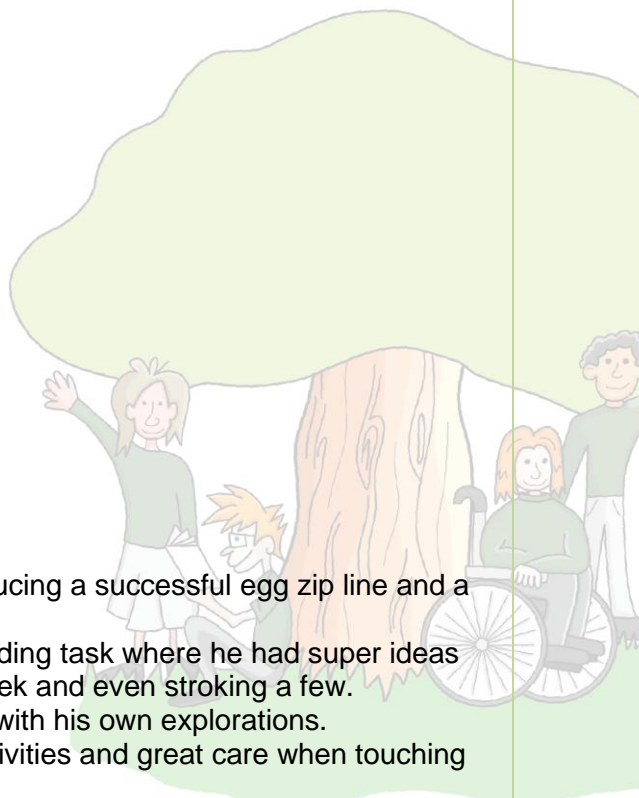
WS - lovely engagement at the start of our Maths lesson, listening to the song and joining in with some shape printing.

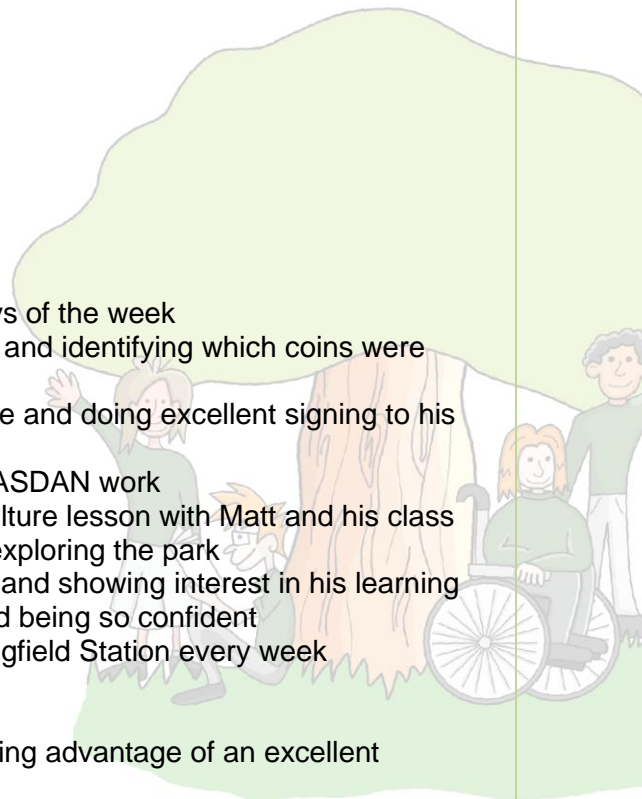
