Reece- For Brilliant focus when exploring the typewriter when at the level centre.

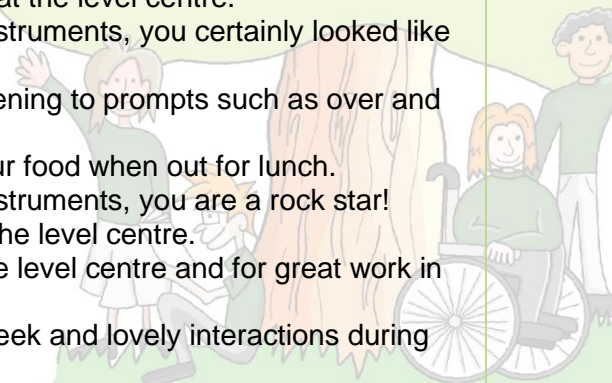
Skye- for lovely interactions with staff and new people when at the level centre and for great work in the pool this week.
