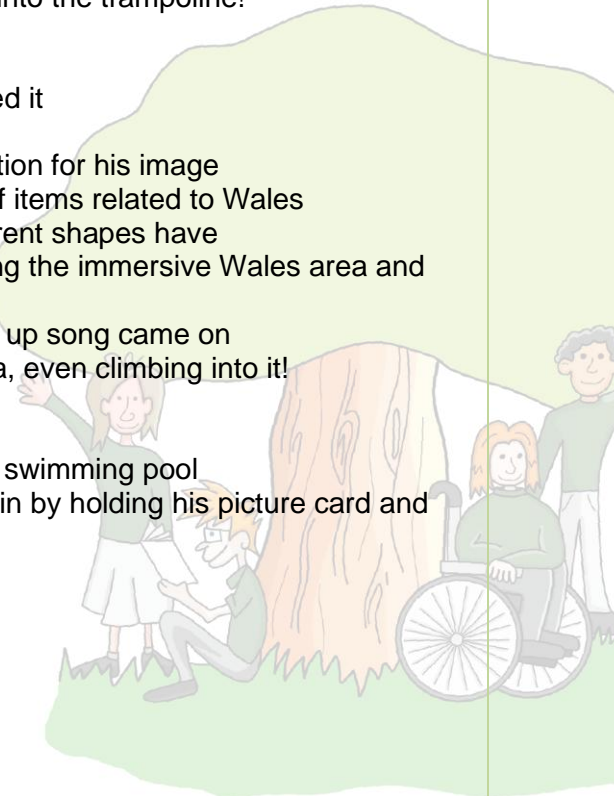
Teddy - for lovely colouring of his favourite character in art

Jared- Brilliant work on using your iPad to tell us what you wanted, keep at it!

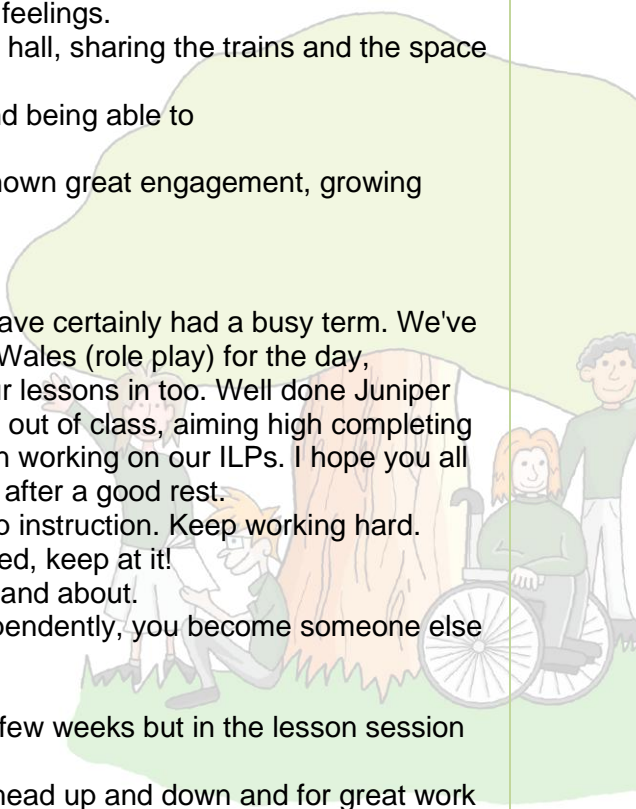
L- Well done for great horse riding. You are so happy when out and about.

TW: Being a star in our English lesson and labelling parts of the face correctly using signs and a lovely visit to Fairplay

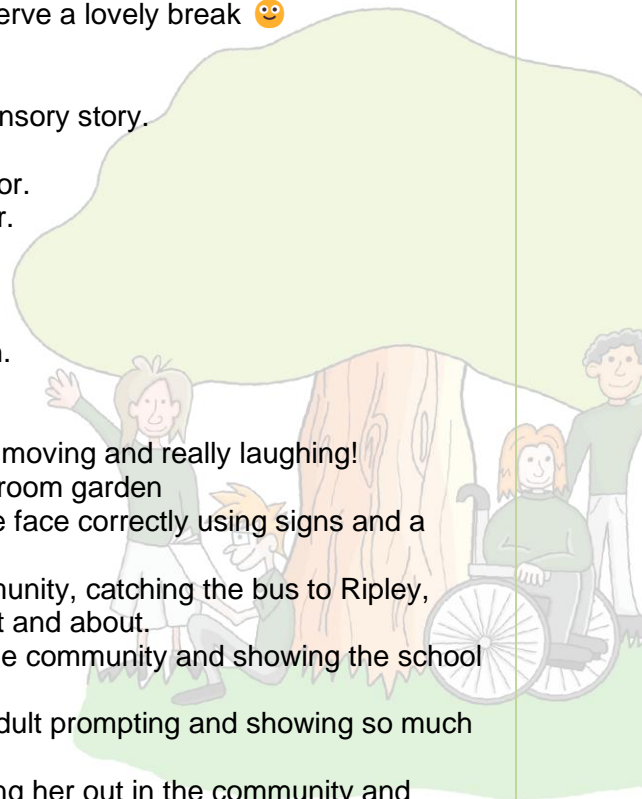
Max H: Being our star of the week for his fantastic visit to community, catching the bus to Ripley, using his gold card and being so polite to people while were out and about.
